Cinquain

I can write Cinquain poetry
by selecting an idea and
using nouns, verbs and
adjectives to describe it

It is a type of poem that uses a 5 line pattern. It incorporates nouns, verbs, adjectives, and a sentence about the subject or topic and synonyms

Line 1= One word that states the subject (NOUN)

Line 2= Two words that describe the subject (ADJECTIVES)

Line 3= Three verbs that relate to the subject

Line 4= A Four word sentence that relates to the subject or expresses a feeling about it

Line 5= One synonym for the subject or a word that sums it up


