Haiku

I can write Haiku poetry by choosing a topic and using syllables to help me describe it

It is a Japanese form of poetry that does not rhyme. It is a poem that describes something in nature. They have 3 lines, with a certain number of syllables in each line.

Line 1= 5 syllables

Line 2= 7 syllables

Line 3= 5 syllables

Line 2= 7 syllables

Line 3= 5 syllables
