Front and Center!

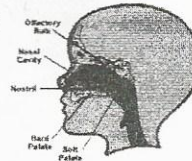
Did you ever stop to smell the roses? Well, this wouldn't be possible without your nose!



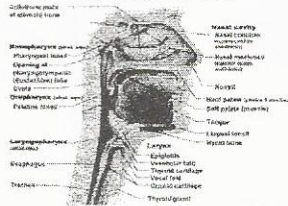
Your nose is front and center on your face. Everyone has one! This part of your body has many purposes.

The nose is part of the respiratory tract.

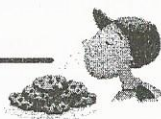
According to the article "The Anatomy of the Nose" by David Terfera and Shereen Jegtgiv The nose has two openings called nostrils
